



Dear Member,

Since 1990 the Great Lakes Ice Cream and Fast Food Association (GLIC&FFA) has sponsored the Ward J. Anderson Scholarship Program for your student employees. One (1) \$3,000.00, one (1) \$2,500.00, one (1) \$1,500.00, and four (4) \$750.00 scholarships are awarded.

To be eligible, student employees must:

- *be high school seniors through college seniors (their 4th year of college in a five-year program),
- *have worked a minimum of three (3) months for a GLIC&FFA member within this year,
- *have a minimum 20 on the ACT composite (1,000 on the SAT)
- *have a minimum 3.0 GPA at the time of applying
- *plan on attending a college, university, or an accredited trade school as a full-time student in the Fall of 2010.

All eligible applications will be read and scored by a committee of three (3) Board of Director members. The highest scoring applicant will receive the \$3,000.00 scholarship. The next four (4) highest scoring applicants will each receive a scholarship. In the event of a tie, a random drawing will be held to break the tie. The additional two (2) \$750.00 scholarships will be awarded through a random drawing of all remaining qualified applicants who have not been awarded one of the first 5 applications. Biographical information is requested to use for press releases.

There are several reasons for beginning the scholarship program. This will be a benefit for members and will assist in competing for the best workers in the labor market. The scholarship program will help deserving students meet college expenses. Finally, the Association and its members will receive a great deal of publicity and good will from the communities where we live.

The Association will present certificates to the recipients' sponsors at the Awards Banquet during our annual convention in January. The scholarship checks will be mailed to the recipient during the following May.

If you have student employees interested in applying, please see that they get this application right away. Additional forms may be downloaded from our website, www.glicffa.com, or contact our office. All applications and required forms must be completed in ink or typed and mailed together in one (1) envelope to be received by November 1, 2010. Three (3) complete sets (copies are acceptable), each set stapled together, must be included in that envelope. Any applications received "postage due" will be returned to the sender. Selections will be made mid-December and all applicants notified of their status. Previous winners are not eligible.

The Great Lakes Ice Cream and Fast Food Association (GLIC&FFA) sponsors the Ward J. Anderson Scholarship Program for employees of its members. Seven (7) scholarships are available; one (1) \$3,000.00 scholarship awarded to the highest score, one (1) \$2,500.00, one (1) \$1,500.00 and two (2) \$750.00 scholarships to the next two (2) highest scoring applicants. An additional two (2) \$750.00 scholarships will be awarded through a random drawing of all remaining qualified applicants who have not been awarded one of the first 5 scholarships. All eligible applications will be read and scored by a committee of three (3) Board of Director members. In the event of a tie, a random drawing will be held to break the tie.

In addition to having worked a minimum of three (3) months during the past year for a GLIC&FFA member, student employees must have a minimum GPA of 3.0, a minimum ACT composite score of 20, or minimum SAT score of 1,000, be high school seniors through college seniors (their 4th year of college in a five-year program), and plan to attend a college, university, or accredited trade school as a full time student in the Fall of 2010.

Because the GPA is an important eligibility requirement, it's essential that the GPA be computed uniformly. We are using a 4.00 for the top grade. If your school uses 4.40 for an A+, or weights the GPA for honors classes, please adjust the GPA to 4.00 for the top grade.

All applications and required forms must be completed in ink or typed and mailed together in one (1) envelope and received by November 1, 2010. Three (3) complete sets (copies are acceptable) with each set stapled together must be included in that envelope. Any applications received "postage due" will be returned to the sender. We will make the selections in mid-December and notify all applicants of their status. The Association will present certificates to their sponsors at the Awards Banquet Dinner during our annual convention in February. The scholarship checks will be mailed to the recipient during the following May. Previous winners are not eligible.

Biographical information is also required to use in press releases, and our Association newsletters. Selections are made mid-December and all applicants are notified of their status. The Association presents certificates to their sponsors at the Awards Banquet during our annual convention in February. The scholarship checks will be mailed to the recipient during the following May.

To apply, please fill out the required application forms in ink or typed. You may submit it to your school principal or counselor. Your school will provide the GPA and ACT or SAT scores, or attach a copy of your most recent transcript. Then mail all required application forms together in the same envelope. Three (3) complete sets (copies are acceptable), each set stapled together, must be included in that envelope. In order to be considered, applications must be in our office by November 1, 2010. Any applications received "postage due" will be returned to the sender. Be sure to allow sufficient time so the school can complete its requirements and meet our deadline. We will make the selections in mid-December and notify all applicants of their status. The Association will present certificates to their sponsors at the Awards Banquet Dinner during our annual convention in February. The scholarship checks will be mailed to the recipient during the following May. Previous winners are not eligible.
